



From the M4:

- Exit at Junction 11 and follow the A33.
 - At the first roundabout (Three Mile Cross) take the 3rd exit in to Mere oak Lane and follow the road for approximately 2.5 miles
 - At the small roundabout as you enter the village, take the second exit in to The Street.
 - Follow this road for 1 mile—you will pass a pub on your right called The Fox and Horn.
 - As you enter Mortimer village's centre The Street becomes Victoria Road.
 - On your left you will see the Horse and Groom pub and then a church. Turn left in to West End Road just after the church
 - The offices are at the beginning of the road and on your left—opposite the Post Office.
 - The entrance to the car park is on the right of the building; please use one of the allocated parking spaces.

From the M3:

- Exit at Junction 6 for Basingstoke and then take the second exit at the Black Dam Roundabout on to the A339 (Ringway East).
- Follow the signs on the A339 in the direction of the hospital and the A340 Aldermaston Road.
- Once on the A340, continue for approximately 5.5 miles until you reach a small roundabout in Tadley.
- Take the third exit, turning right in to Rowan Road. Follow Rowan Road and then Pamber Heath Road until you reach a T-Junction.
- Turn right in to Silchester Road. After the garage, take the second left signposted to Mortimer.
- Follow this road for 1.5 mile (you will pass the Red Lion Pub) until you reach a T-Junction. Turn right towards Mortimer and continue for 1 mile.
- The offices are situated on the right, opposite the Post Office.
- The entrance to the car park is on the right of the building; please use one of the allocated parking spaces.
